This is a unique training opportunity open to anyone aged 16-26 looking to develop new skills and gain hands on experience in Sound, Lighting, Rigging, Carpentry, Operation of Specialist Equipment, Stage & Venue Management, Health & Safety, Pyrotechnics and much more.

Our Technical Director backed up by a professional team of theatre technicians will work with you to build the festival from the ground up.

You'll get to work with stateof-the-art equipment provided by our sponsors in professional venues such as Curve Theatre. A full 2-day induction precedes a bespoke week-long course of learning through doing that includes transforming empty spaces into fully functioning theatres and providing technical support for all the shows and events at the festival.

This year, we have launched an exciting partnership with **PLEASANCE THEATRES**, the legendary Edinburgh and London Venues.

This collaboration will allow us to offer placements and pathways which begin at NSDF but then move to the Edinburgh Festival and then onwards to further famous festival partners.

No previous experience is required. This opportunity is ideal for complete beginners and those with more experience looking to launch their careers as theatre technicians.

NSDF 22 will take place across various venues in Leicester. You will need to be available from 7th-15th April 2022 to take part. Accommodation will be provided by NSDF.

1. What is NSDF?

NSDF is a week-long annual festival that showcases the best theatre created by 16-26-year olds from all over the UK. Alongside this, we offer 100+ workshops, discussions and events. NSDF 22 will take place in various venues across Leicester City. At NSDF, talent is spotted and coached and lives get changed. You get to be part of something. 2. What will my week look like?

Honestly, no two days at NSDF will look the same. As a team, you will learn how to build the festival venues and set up the shows, work with the Technical Director and our professional team of technicians to provide full technical support to the operation of the festival, attend workshops (you are free to take part in any of our workshops over the week, not just those on technical theatre!), watch the performances and (if you like) attend the evening social events.

3. How much will it cost?

NSDF 22 will be completely free to attend. NSDF will provide meals for everyone on the Technical Team and accommodation for those who need it.

4. Who else will be on the Technical Team with me?

You will be joined by a group of other 16-26-year olds from across the UK looking to learn more about technical theatre and start their careers as technicians. You may be a complete beginner, or have lots of experience; either way, our Technical Director will make sure you are provided the appropriate level of mentorship and support you need.

5. Who will be teaching me?

Marec Joyce is our Technical Director for NSDF 22. Marec will be joined by a team of professional theatre technicians who will work with you over the week.

6. What other Festival Teams can I apply to be on?

As well as our Technical Team, we also have a Management Team and Noises Off Writers Team. The Management Team help us produce the festival week and is for those who would like to gain experience in Front of House, Box Office, Venues, Producing & Event Management. Our Noises Off Writers Team write for our Festival Magazine. You are welcome to apply for any of the teams but you will have to choose one if accepted. There are plenty of opportunities to attend workshops and masterclasses in lots of different areas of theatre, so if you would like to take part in the Technical Team but have interests in something other than technical theatre, you will still get the chance to explore this over the week.

7. Will the festival meet my access requirements?

NSDF is committed to making the festival as accessible as possible. We will contact all successful candidates after the application process to talk through any access requirements they have and how we can meet these.
